Concrete plays a crucial role in achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by promoting resource efficiency through recycled materials and industrial by-products, enhancing energy efficiency in buildings, and providing durable and resilient infrastructure. Innovations like carbon capture and alternative binders reduce its carbon footprint, while permeable concrete aids in water conservation. Concrete also supports economic growth by creating jobs and enabling affordable housing, contributing to clean energy, sustainable cities, and climate action.

The conference will explore Green Solutions in Concrete Structures, Advances in Concrete Technology, 3D Printing - Challenges and Future Prospects, and innovative practices in Precast and Prestressed Concrete. Examples such as the 3D-printed bridge in Shanghai and the 3D-printed office building in Dubai demonstrate the potential for reducing material waste and construction time. Additionally, Structural Health Monitoring (SHM) is vital for ensuring the safety and longevity of infrastructure worldwide. In India, SHM is used in the Bandra-Worli Sea Link, Chenab Rail Bridge, and Kochi Metro to enhance safety. Globally, iconic structures like the Golden Gate Bridge in the USA, Millau Viaduct in France, and Tsing Ma Bridge in Hong Kong use SHM to detect issues early, reduce maintenance costs, and ensure reliability. By providing real-time data and early warnings.

The organizers aim to provide delegates with valuable insights and memorable experiences, fostering collaboration and innovation in sustainable engineering practices.

ABOUT HYDERABAD

Hyderabad is the capital of the South Indian State - Telangana. It is home to vibrant ecosystem of cosmopolitan and multi-cultural diverse societies dotted with many upscale restaurants and shops. Hyderabad is known as the City of Pearls, as it had once flourished as a global center for trade of rare diamonds, emeralds as well as natural pearls. The Birla Mandir, Charminar, Golconda fort, are some of the historic structures. The Charminar, a 16th-century mosque whose 4 arches support towering minarets, is an old city landmark near the long-standing Laad Bazaar. The Statue of Equality is a statue of the 11th-century Indian philosopher Ramanuja, located on the premises of the Chinna Jeeyar Trust at Muchintal, Ranga Reddy district in the outskirts of Hyderabad. It is the second tallest sitting statue in the world. It's the fourth largest city in India and the largest city in Telangana, with a population of over 12.2 million. It's also a major urban center for south- central interior India.

Hyderabad has developed into one of the major hubs for the information technology industry in India which has earned it the additional sobriquet "Cyberabad". In addition to the IT industry, various biotechnology and pharmaceuticals companies have set up their operations in Hyderabad owing to its established Public sector in Life Science Research and Genome Valley.

The city houses the most expensive residential real estate in Telangana in Banjara Hills and Jubilee Hills. The city is home to the Telugu Film Industry, either the second- or third-largest in India, depending on the basis of measurement, known popularly as Tollywood.
