Preamble

Since independence, many civil engineering structures such as buildings, roads, bridges, flyovers, canals, dams, airports, sea ports, industrial structures etc. have been constructed in India. With the passage of time, some structures face problems due to aging and other reasons such as change in usage of structure, changes in codal provisions, improper selection or application of material, deficiencies in design & detailing, poor workmanship, earthquakes, cyclones, environment condition etc. To resolve these problems, Repair Rehabilitation and Retrofitting (termed as 3R hereinafter) of structures is a better strategy than reconstruction, as this is sustainable as well as cost and time effective. Therefore, repair, rehabilitation and retrofitting of structures is a fast growing segment in the construction sector, covering public as well as private infrastructure. This segment covers residential, institutional, commercial, industrial, infrastructure and all other sectors of human activities. Its demand is growing by leaps and bounds.

Problems in a structure can be mitigated by proper understanding of the causes for distress, selection of appropriate repair / rehabilitation / retrofitting strategy and its proper execution.

Some structures require enhancement of its strength and stability due to changes and/or increase in its functional requirements, loading conditions etc. The performance of such structures may be enhanced by application of modern materials and construction techniques for 3R.

There has been development of innovative, high performance and durable materials as well as state of art techniques to carry out 3Rs and also for structural health monitoring.

In this context, Indian Concrete Institute is organizing a national level conference to spread knowledge among practicing engineers and professionals on the latest technological developments in repair, rehabilitation and retrofitting (3R) of structures. 


